Ancestors Gathering

Applications and activities will be considered on an individual basis by the Steering Committee and they reserve the right to refuse any group or business that does not uphold the integrity of the Festival. Late application may reduce the chances of securing space due to expanded Festival activity.

1. All applications must include a Festival entry and booth permit fee.
2. Participants must provide all materials used in the construction of or in connection with demonstration or display and must be completely constructed 30 minutes prior to Festival opening time and may not be removed until exhibitor closing time.
3. Vehicles will be allowed to enter and unload and must be removed as soon as unloading is finished. All vehicles must be out of the Festival grounds 30 minutes prior to the opening of the Festival. Special arrangements shall be provided for the physically challenged and certain activities and events.
VEHICLES CANNOT BE PARKED IN EXHIBIT AREA.
4. Sale of items is limited to applicants with prior approval for sales of the type of merchandise being sold.
5. Sales or "Hawking" of any items outside the assigned booth space is prohibited.
6. Pets are prohibited on Festival grounds by Ypsilanti City Ordinance.
7. No debris may be left behind after tearing down.
8. Decisions by any Festival Committee may be appealed to the Steering Committee.
9. Photos may be taken of your booth or display for use in promotional materials.
10. Vendors are responsible for all required Michigan State Licenses
11. Upon arrival you will be provided with a welcome packet, which includes a Hold Harmless Agreement that must be signed prior to participation.

You may not dismantle your booth or exhibit until 7pm Sunday evening.

To ensure the safety of our guests and vendors, no cars are permitted to enter the park on Sunday evening until after the 7:00pm closing once permitted by order of the Ypsilanti Police Chief.

Violations of these rules will cause immediate dismissal without refund of any fees.
