You are invited...to apply for Market Place booth space at the 32nd Ypsilanti Heritage Festival, drawing 100,000 in attendance over a three-day period in and around Riverside Park along the banks of the Huron River in historic Ypsilanti.

The Heritage Festival is one of southeastern Michigan's oldest and largest events. Arts & crafts, children's activities, music, parade, re-enactments, and many other activities will round out this celebration of community and history only minutes away from Canton, Chelsea, Plymouth, Belleville and Ann Arbor.

Application

1. Please include completed application, hold harmless agreement and payment of fee.
2. No refunds will be given after acceptance by Festival of your application.
3. Attach a full list of all items to be distributed, given away or sold.
4. A notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent to you.
5. You will be provided with a vendor packet upon check-in that will include your vendor permit, parking pass, general Festival information and a Hold Harmless Agreement that must be signed at check-in

Responsibilities:

1. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own booth, tables, and displays.
2. They should be prepared for uneven ground, pavement or grass.
3. Exhibitors who have requested electricity must provide a minimum of 100' of electrical cord.
4. Set up will begin at 5pm Thursday evening or Friday at 8:00am.
5. It is the responsibility of Market Place participants to secure their booth and exhibits overnight.
6. PLEASE read the Ypsilanti Heritage Festival Participants Regulations carefully before you apply.
